Advisor's Notes/Recommendations:

- Declaration of nursing major does not guarantee entrance to the nursing program. Application process and acceptance is required.
- The A.S. Nursing transfers into the RN to Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN) program at ENMU.
- In order to improve student success and reduce unnecessary attrition, all students must take the University Skills Placement Test and any required pre-requisite course work prior to being accepted into the nursing program. More information may be found at: [ENMU-Roswell EDReady Student Guide](#)
- All lectures and corresponding labs must be taken simultaneously.
- For nursing program acceptance, student must have a grade point average of 2.75 calculated using **all required prerequisite courses**
- Student must have an ENMU Campus System cumulative grade point average of 2.0 in order to meet university graduation requirements.
- Submit a Graduation Application by the application deadline listed on the university calendar the semester preceding the expected completion date.

Program Requirements:

- Have a current BLS card through the **American Heart Association (AHA)** by the start of each semester (Red Cross certification is not accepted)
- All applicants must achieve a minimum of **58.7%** in **each content area** to include Reading, Math, Science, and English and Language of the TEAS (Test of Essential Academic Skills) prior to being accepted into the Nursing Program. Applicants are allowed two attempts to achieve the score per entry cycle, results are good for one year. You may find more information or register at <https://www.atitesting.com/teas/register>
- Mandatory routine and random Drug screening test will be administered throughout the nursing program.
- Nationwide FBI background checks are required for all students in the nursing program. The background checks will be scheduled during the first two weeks of the semester. Students must contact the Nursing Program Director if they have a felony conviction within the last 7 years, or a misdemeanor conviction involving alcohol, drugs, or family violence within the last 3 years
- A grade of "C" or better in all program required courses listed in the degree plan.
- A failed or attempted nursing course must be repeated during the next semester the course is offered if space is available. An application for re-entry must be submitted
- An application for entry **and** re-entry must be submitted for each admission cycle. Due dates, information, directions, and applications may be found at: [ENMU-Roswell Nursing Webpage](#)
- **Students must have successfully completed a Nursing assisting program, Certified Medical Assisting program, EMT Basic, Intermediate, Paramedic course or have current certification with the Nurse Aide Registry. Certification is not required, only proof of successful completion.**
