Tax Year 2022 Filing Thresholds by Filing Status

| Filing Status | Taxpayer age at the end of 2022 | A taxpayer must file a return if their gross income was at least: |

| single | under 65 | \$12,950 |
| single | 65 or older | \$14,700 |
| head of household | under 65 | \$19,400 |
| head of household | 65 or older | \$21,150 |
| married filing jointly | under 65 (both spouses) | \$25,900 |
| married filing jointly | 65 or older (one spouse) | \$27,300 |
| married filing jointly | 65 or older (both spouses) | \$28,700 |
| married filing separately | any age | \$5 |
| qualifying surviving spouse | under 65 | \$25,900 |
| qualifying surviving spouse | 65 or older | \$27,300 |
