The academic programs and adult education services offered by our outstanding faculty and staff members provide transformational opportunities for our students. These programs allow students to reach personal, professional, and academic goals which can be truly lifechanging by benefitting the individual student, their family, and the community.



With the start of the fall term our ongoing leadership training for students, faculty, and staff will begin in September. Students will have the opportunity to join leadership seminars that will be held throughout the year in the Learning Resources Center. I encourage all members of our campus community to make use of these resources. For faculty and staff members professional development is also available through academic classes and degree programs offered throughout the ENMU system campuses. As an ENMU-Roswell faculty or staff member you have the option to complete specific classes or earn an associate, bachelor's, or master's degree. Please talk to your supervisor and our Human Resources department to get more information on these career development opportunities.

Powell and McClelland receive Kosa Merit Awards



The ENMU-Roswell Foundation recognized Justin Powell and Kathrine McClelland as the 2024 Kosa Merit Award recipients. Powell is the EMS Program Director and McClelland is the Psychology & Behavioral Instructor.

Long before the current campus complex existed, William and Ethel Kosa contributed a gift of \$31,000 to Roswell Community College. Their generosity eventually led to the establishment of the ENMU-Roswell Foundation, a source of scholarships and funds for students and faculty. The Kosa Merit Award, instituted in 1970, recognizes two instructors each year for excellence in teaching, rapport with students, professional achievements, and service to the institution. Chosen by their peers, the honorees receive an engraved plaque and a stipend of \$500.
