Program Overview

The Professional Pilot Training (PPT) program at ENMU-Roswell is proud to offer an Associate of Science degree in Professional Pilot Training. Students in the Professional Pilot Program will earn a Private Pilot License, then a Commercial Pilot's License and will complete a comprehensive core of both academic courses and degree specific training. Students will find that flight training in New Mexico provides a wide variety of weather conditions, terrain features, and airport complexities.

Program Courses

The Professional Pilot program may be completed in three semesters if previous college credit has been awarded. This will be decided on a case by case basis.
